## **Creating Movies of your FX-Viewer files**

Creating a movie of your FX-Viewer design to show to your customer or for use as marketing tools for your sales force, blogs, website tutorials or presentations is extremely simple:

Using the built-in features of QuickTime to record your computer screen

- 1. Open an image within FX-Viewer and set your preview settings
- 2. Open guicktime (10.0 version) Click on FILE / NEW SCREEN RECORDING.
- 3. click on the record button to capture the screen



- Click inside the FX-Viewer window and rotate and zoom to animate your movie content.
- 5. When you are happy with the video animation, **STOP** the screen capture recording:



## **QUICKTIME TIPS**

- 1. SHORT BUT SWEET: The longer your video/animation, the larger the file size of your movie.
- 2. **TRIM YOUR EXCESS:** Open your screen recording within QuickTime and TRIM the selection to remove any unwanted data from the front and back of the screen capture.
- 3. SAVE FOR WEB: Reduce the size of your movie. FILE/SAVE FOR WEB.
